The nurse meets the child and guardian at the site to discuss arrangements for future visits and provide reassurance about the procedures.

The visit is conducted. Where possible the child sees the same nurse at each visit. That way they can build up a rapport.



The Research Nurse remains with the child for a set amount of time after dosing to monitor them. Serious adverse events are reported to the investigator immediately and action taken where necessary.

The Research Nurse handles all the visit requirements, such as liaising with pharmacy and courier to deliver the IMP.

The IMP (study drug) can be delivered under controlled conditions by courier to the Research Nurse who treats the child.

Visits can take place in any approved, familiar environment such as home or school.

A more patient centric trial will often lead to easier, quicker enrollment and higher retention rates. This makes the investment worthwhile.
